Haysville School Allegheny County's Last One-Room School



Until 1937, Haysville's original one-room schoolhouse sat perched on the hillside overlooking the Beaver Road. It was during construction of the Ohio River Boulevard that Allegheny County razed the school and replaced it with a newly built one-room brick building at the corner of River and Beaver roads.

The replacement school continued to operate until September 1956 when Haysville formally joined the newly created Quaker Valley Joint School District and its students were bussed to Osborne Elementary and Sewickley Junior-High. Haysville School had the distinction of being the last one-room school to close in Allegheny County.
