OLD BUSINESS

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 313 - Lighting

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELL ACRES, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 165 IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELL ACRES, "ZONING," TO REGULATE LIGHTING WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

Discussion was made by Mr. Abell and referred to the letter that was part of the exhibits from the Public Hearing the letter dated January 30, 2023. The general comment in the letter stated to consider the Ordinance not be contained within the Zoning Ordinance. It could have been a standalone Ordinance. Mr. Junker stated that we could put it into a public hearing with another ordinance change as the concern from Mr. Abell is advertising costs and legal fees.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELL ACRES, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 165 IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELL ACRES, "ZONING", AS AMENDED, TO REGULATE CRYPTOCURRENCY MINING AND DATA CENTERS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

PUBLIC SAFETY - BROCK MEANOR

Mr. Meanor announced a grant award received from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime & Delinquency (PCCD) for the Bell Acres Police Department for an updated Records Management System and Evidence Management System (RMS). The application amount was \$35,513.

OVCOG Police Department Shared Mobile Fingerprint Scanner Policy

A motion to approve the QVCOG Police Department Shared Mobile Fingerprint Scanner Policy was made by Mr. Meanor, seconded by Mr. Abell. All in favor. Motion carried.

This scanner will be permanently located in Edgeworth Borough.

Review and discuss the first draft of proposed Ordinance No. 321 — No Parking Ordinance

Mr. Meanor opened up the discussion - this would limit parking on both sides of Bower Drive, Hamilton Drive, Kennelly Street, Lewis Street and Sands Avenue. Summerlawn Drive would limit the no parking on the West and no parking on either side of the island and the cul de sac. At present there is no issue on Summerlawn Drive. No signs will be posted until problems arise. No person shall park a vehicle upon any Borough Street during snow removal from November 1 thru April 15th. The Ordinance will be on our next meeting's agenda.

PUBLIC WORKS – CHRISTOPHER ABELL

Camp Meeting Road closure is still on schedule and tentatively to open by end of April. Mr. Abell stated that, our 15-year road plan will not make it with the plan in place and would like to possibly be able to tar and chip some of the roads, as this is reasonably less expensive, so the roads hold up until they get paved.

2023 Major Road Improvement Project

A motion to authorize the Borough Engineer, Shoup Engineering, Inc. to begin the bidding process for the road work and concrete replacement necessary for the 2023 portion of the Borough's 15-Year Road Improvement Project of Grouse Lane was made by Mr. Abell, seconded by Mr. Meanor. All in favor. Motion carried.

PROPERTY & SUPPLIES – CHARLES KULBACKI

Professional Services Agreement with Shoup Engineering, Inc. for the professional services performed on DCNR's Grant Award No. BRC-SC-28-23 of the Bell Acres Borough Park Project.

A motion to approve the Professional Services Agreement with Shoup Engineering, Inc. for the services performed on the Bell Acres Borough Park Project in the amount of \$10,000 as required by DCNR for the Small Community Program Grants was made by Mr. Kulbacki, seconded by Mrs. Veeck. All in favor. Motion carried.
