Bell Acres Borough received a successful grant award from the Commonwealth Financing Authority for the purchase of equipment and a police vehicle.

Senator Devlin Robinson and State Representative Valerie Gaydos presented a check in the amount of \$169,976 to Bell Acres Borough. The grant money will be used to replace aging equipment, which includes a backhoe, commercial mower, and a police vehicle.

The funding was made possible through the Local Share Account Program, which supports economic development, community improvement and public interest projects through the gaming revenues.
